

# COVID-19 CHEAT SHEET 2022-2023

## SYMPTOMATIC STUDENTS & EMPLOYEES

Fever, any new or worsening respiratory symptoms, or loss of taste or smell should be sent home/not report to campus and referred to PCP for guidance.

Nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, sore throat, headache, congestion, runny nose, body aches, or lethargy - If only experiencing one symptom, treat per normal protocols. If experiencing more than one symptom, send home/not report to campus and refer to PCP.

## COVID-19 POSITIVE STUDENTS & EMPLOYEES

Determine the date of onset of symptoms - this is day zero. Day one is the first full day after the onset of symptoms. May return on day 6 if feeling well and fever free. If not feeling well or running fever on day 5, stay home until fever resolves and symptoms improve.

If positive and asymptomatic, date of test is day zero of five.

Masking at all times when around others is required days 6-10.

## CONTACT TRACING

To determine who was in close contact, look at the first day symptoms began (or date of positive test for asymptomatic) and count back two days. Take those those two days and any days going forward the individual was on campus.

Anyone who is identified as having significant exposure during the contagious period will be notified.

## IF EXPOSED

**Employees and students can choose to quarantine if exposed to someone who has tested positive. This decision to quarantine is up to the student's guardian or the employee.**

**If they choose to quarantine, they should follow the most up to date CDC guidance for quarantining after exposure. They may also chose to end their quarantine at any time if they are symptom free. Anyone exposed should consider testing after 5 days and anytime they are symptomatic.**

## IF QUARANTINING

If a student or employee is choosing to quarantine, they must let the campus principal/immediate supervisor know.

## REMOTE LEARNING/WORK

Remote learning is not available at this time. Students, who are absent due to quarantine or isolation, will have an excused absence and will have make up work provided.

Employees cannot work remotely at this time, and there is no additional paid COVID leave.

If an employee is off for quarantine or isolation, they will use their sick/personal days.

## FAQS

- We cannot require students or employees to test or quarantine.
- Elementary parents will be notified if multiple cases are reported within the classroom via a letter in the student's backpack or on the digital platform the classroom teacher uses to communicate with parents.
- Secondary parents will be notified if multiple cases are reported on a team, in a club/group/organization via a recorded call out and an email.
- Campus nurses, the health services department and HR will provide employees and families with up to date COVID testing locations.
- Campus COVID cases will be published on the Waco ISD Dashboard.
